ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #116 ON CHANGES TO LOCAL RULES EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2017

It is hereby ordered that the following rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Georgia are changed or added effective December 1, 2017:

LBR 1015-1, 2002-1, LBR 4003-2, LBR 7056-1, and LBR 9010-3

LBR 1015-1 reflects changes to the Federal rules regarding cases involving two or more debtors.

LBR 2002-1 adds subparagraph (a)(9) in accordance with a change to the Federal rules regarding time fixed for objections to claim and confirmation hearings in Chapter 13 cases.

LBR 4003-2 is updated to include Chapter 12 plans to be served in accordance with LBR 9004-1.

LBR 7056-1 adds a time limit for replies to respondent's response, brief, or affidavit.

LBR 9010-3 makes the Middle District of Georgia District Court Local Rule 83.2.1 regarding Standards of Professional Conduct and Discipline applicable to the Bankruptcy Court.

On or after the effective date as noted above, this rule shall govern all proceedings then pending or thereafter brought to the court.

It is further ordered that this rule be entered in the record upon the minutes of the court for each of the statutory divisions and that copies be made available by the Clerk of Court to officers and members of the Bar of this court and furnished to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals.
