ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #144 ON CHANGE TO LOCAL RULES
EFFECTIVE JANUARY 3, 2022

It is hereby ordered that the following rule of the United States Bankruptcy Court of the Middle District of Georgia is added effective January 3, 2022:

LBR 1016-1 – Suggestion of Death


The rule is added to require the debtor's attorney to file a Suggestion of Death upon the death of a debtor.

On or after the effective date as noted above, this rule shall govern all proceedings then pending or thereafter brought to the court.
