ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER #113 ON CHANGE TO LBR 3015-2 AND 3015-3

It is hereby ordered that the following rule of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Georgia is changed effective July 5, 2017:

LBR 3015-2 and LBR 3015-3

LBR 3015-2 requires the use of a form for modifications to Chapter 13 plans. One form is used for modifications that require a rescheduled hearing and another form is for modifications that do not require a rescheduled hearing. LBR 3015-3 changes the language on service requirements to be consistent with language in the new forms.

On or after the effective date as noted above, this rule shall govern all proceedings then pending or thereafter brought to the court.

It is further ordered that this rule be entered in the record upon the minutes of the court for each of the statutory divisions and that copies be made available by the Clerk of Court to officers and members of the Bar of this court and furnished to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals.
