REAPPOINTMENT OF INCUMBENT BANKRUPTCY ADMINISTRATOR NORTHERN DISTRICT OF ALABAMA

The current five-year term of J. Thomas Corbett, United States Bankruptcy Administrator for the Northern District of Alabama, expires 4 December 2021.
