Subject: Addition of LBR 1016-1 Suggestion of Death November 22, 2021

1. The Court does not have a requirement that an attorney file a Suggestion of Death when a debtor dies. LBR 1016-1 Suggestion of Death is proposed to provide the mechanism to ensure all parties are noticed when a debtor dies during the pendency of the case.

2. The proposed rule is as follows:

LBR 1016-1 Suggestion of Death The attorney for the debtor(s) shall file and serve on all parties in interest in the bankruptcy case a notice of the debtor's(s') death as soon as possible after verifying that the debtor(s) is(are) deceased.
